

RUGBY AND DISTRICT ART SOCIETY AWARDS EXHIBITION 2019

Please note change in entry procedure to allow production of an exhibition catalogue.

Exhibition to be held in Floor One Gallery, Rugby Art Gallery Museum and Library, Little Elborow Street, Rugby CV21 3BZ.

Open to the Public Saturday 23rd November 2019 to Thursday 5th December 2019 (Closed on Mondays).

All current members of Rugby and District Art Society are invited to exhibit.

Deadline for Entries Wednesday 6th November 2019.

Work to be handed in between 12.30 pm and 2.30 pm on Friday 22nd November 2019.

Collection of unsold work between 10.30 am and 11.30 am on Friday 6th December 2019.

Awards will be presented to winners on Wednesday 4th December at 7.30pm in Dunchurch Village Hall.

HOW TO ENTER

Completed entry forms should be handed in at the regular monthly meeting on 6th November or posted to the Rugby and District Art Society Treasurer, 59 Wordsworth Road Rugby CV22 6HZ to arrive before the closing date of Wednesday 6th November. Please note that in order to produce an exhibition catalogue in time for the opening, the title, medium and price of work to be displayed (other than browser bar or cards) must be submitted at the time of entry.

WE CANNOT ACCEPT CHANGES TO THE SUBMISSIONS AFTER THE ENTRY CLOSING DATE.

The works which can be exhibited are as follows:

FRAMED PICTURES

A maximum of two, maximum size 30" including frame, on longest side. These must be original work by the artist and not giclee prints nor exhibited in any previous RADAS Exhibition.

Work for hanging can only be accepted if provided with a cord strong enough to support them. Also a label should be attached by a string long enough to hang over the front of the picture to allow the work to be identified during hanging. Please note that work in photographic frames

with the shelf display supports still attached or hangers riveted to the backing board are NOT acceptable.

BROWSER BAR PICTURES

A maximum of 4 mounted but unframed pictures, maximum size 32" x 26" including the mount. Protect pictures with clear plastic and attach a label on the back with the title, price and your name.

3D WORK

A maximum of 6 of which only 2 may be wall hung. Because of the space constraints in Floor 1 we cannot accept floor standing works.

GREETING CARDS

A maximum of 40 which will be displayed in a rack supplied by the Society.

ENTRY FEES

For each 2D or 3D work hung – £2

For each 3D on plinths etc – £1

For each item in the browser bar – £1

IMPORTANT – If you intend to exhibit pictures in the browser bar, or sell cards, collect the appropriate sheet at the monthly meeting and list your entries. The completed sheets should be handed in with the work and will be used by the treasurer to pay for sales after the exhibition.

STEWARDING

To ensure the exhibition is supervised at all times, two stewards have to be on duty at any one time. Each exhibitor **MUST** give at least two hours to this task and more if possible. Indicate your availability on the rota available at the November meeting. On arrival at the exhibition familiarise yourselves with the sales procedures and sales folders.

INSURANCE

Third Party indemnity insurance is provided by the Rugby and District Art Society but damage and theft is not covered. Individual insurance of the work is the responsibility of the exhibitor.

SALES

Rugby and District Art Society will levy a commission of 10% on all sales.
